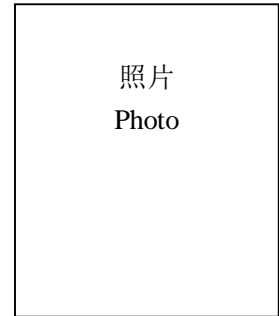

CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT

Students who intend to participate in RISH programs must agree to comply with the following Code of Conduct in order to be enrolled in a program.

1. Students must attend every class and complete homework on time.
2. Students must respect teachers, follow instructions from authorized persons, take care of their study materials, keep classrooms clean after use and take responsibility for their own behavior.
3. Students must respect their peers and other people involved in the program, and not harass, threaten, intimidate, harm or insult anyone.
4. Students must not be involved in any fights or commit any violent or illegal acts under Chinese law or the law of their home country.
5. Students must look after their own personal property and must not cause any damage to school property or property belonging to anyone else.
6. Students must be honest, must not lie or steal, and must use polite language and gestures at all times.
7. Individual students under 18 years of age are NOT allowed to leave the campus by themselves.
8. Parents/visitors should ALWAYS SIGN the leave-for-absent sheet before taking students out of campus.
9. No smoking, drinking alcohol, or use of illegal drugs is allowed.
10. Students must sleep in their assigned rooms and beds.
11. At 10:00 pm students MUST be in their rooms and must not be disruptive to other students.



12. Minor violations will

receive an oral warning. Serious or repeated violations may result in dismissal from the program and, for students under 18 years of age, will be notified to parents/legal guardians.

RELEASE ITEMS

1. I, the undersigned, an applicant for a program of RISH Learning Center (referred to as RISH), acknowledge that the program fees and information are correct at the time of publication.

2. I agree to buy adequate levels of medical, accidental injury and public liability insurance in my own country to cover the travel to and from the Program and the period of their participation in the Program. I shall provide evidence of this insurance to RISH Learning Center, I shall bear all responsibility or liability if I do not take out insurance.

3. I will comply with RISH and any host institution's rules and regulations while I am a participant in RISH's program during the program period; I agree to observe and obey Chinese laws and regulations, and accept Chinese social morality and customs.

4. Waiver

a) I agree to release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue RISH, its affiliated organizations, its administrators, directors, agents, independent contractors and other employees and volunteers of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, host institutions, sponsors, advertisers, under any theory of law or equity for any injury, loss, liability, damage, accident, delay or expense resulting from events beyond its control, including (without limitation) acts of God, war, act of terrorism, strikes, riots, incidents of politically motivated violence, sickness or quarantine, government restrictions or regulations or, in the absence of their own negligence, arising from the use of any vehicle or from the selection or any act or mission of any host family, steamship, airline, railroad, bus company, taxi service, hotel, restaurant, school, university or other firm, agency, company or individual.

b) It is my understanding that participation in the activities that make up RISH programs is not without some inherent risk of injury. As such, in consideration of my participation in RISH programs, I

hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue RISH its affiliated organizations, its administrators, directors, agents, independent contractors and other employees and volunteers of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, host institutions, sponsors, advertisers, from any and all loss, liability, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me, whether caused by the negligence of a release or otherwise while participating in such activity, or while in or upon the premises where the activity is being conducted.

- c) I hereby grant RISH and its affiliated organizations full authority to take whatever actions they may consider to be warranted due to any international or political unrest, personal emergency or other event regarding my health and safety, and I fully release each of them from any liability for such decisions or actions as may be taken in connection therewith.

5. Standards of Conduct

I agree that RISH, its affiliated organizations, and the host institution shall have the right to enforce appropriate standards of conduct and that it may at any time terminate my participation in its program for failure to maintain these standards or for any actions or conduct which RISH, its affiliated organizations, and the host institution consider to be incompatible with the interest, harmony, comfort and welfare of other students, staff, or the laws of the People's Republic of China. I hereby waive and release all claims against RISH, its affiliated organizations, and the host institution arising out of my failure to remain under such supervision or to comply with such rules, standards and instructions, and any consequences thereof. I will also accept in good faith the instructions and suggestions of RISH and its affiliated organizations in all matters relating to RISH 's programs or the personal conduct of program participants.

6. Termination of Participation I agree that I shall have no right to any refund of any part of my program fee upon termination of my participation from the program and that upon notice by RISH or its affiliated organizations, whether verbally or in writing, I shall forthwith depart from the program and return home at my own (or my financial guarantor's) expense. I also understand that, if I leave the program voluntarily for any reason, there will be no refund of fees already paid.
7. Visas and Travel Documents I understand and accept that it is my responsibility to obtain the Chinese visa and/or other required travel documents and in the event I cannot obtain the visa for participation I shall not hold RISH responsible. Failure to secure the necessary visa does not constitute grounds for a refund.

8. Program price includes and excludes:

Program price includes:

- * Enrollment fee
- * Course fee including classroom instruction, textbooks and study materials
- * Activity fees as per the Program Schedule
- * Certificate issued by BLCU – RISH Learning Center
- * 24/7 bilingual counselors and supervisors for the group of students
